City of Rhinelander Residents
Spring Bulk Item Disposal Program
May 13 – May 24, 2019

This program is for bulk item waste disposal only.

City Residents may dispose of bulk items wastes when they are delivered to the City Street Department during the program scheduled dates. Residents who dispose of materials will be required to demonstrate residency with use of photo identification or similar. Residents missing this deadline will need to haul bulk item waste otherwise to alternative landfill facilities at their own expense.

Bulk item disposal will be provided by Eagle Waste & Recycling, Inc. on behalf of the City of Rhinelander for this scheduled event without costs being charged direct to Residents provided service. This is a Resident program that may require Resident payment for separate events conducted in the future. Bulk item services will observe the following rules and conditions:

- **The City will not pick up bulk items from curb side under this program, only bulk item materials delivered to the designated City location may be disposed. Resident deliveries are to be made to City Street Department, 644 Washington Street, Rhinelander, WI 54501.**
- Non-residents, as well as commercial, industrial, and institutional properties located in City service area will not be eligible or allowed use of this service.
- Delivery hours will be from 7 am to 3 pm, May 13 through May 24, 2019.
- Bulk item wastes disposed shall include materials that are designated as bulk, electronic, scrap metal, or appliance type wastes described as follows:
 1. Bulk Items: Non-Metal Items, Furniture, Carpeting, Scrap Lumber, Mattresses, Housewares, and Glass Windows.
 2. Electronic Items: Electronics, TVs, Monitors, Keyboards, Stereos, Amps, Printers/Copiers, and VCR/DVDs.
 3. Scrap Metal Items: Metallic materials and appliances (dishwashers, Microwaves, stoves, vacuum, washer/dryers, and toilets) **without Freon** content.
 4. Appliances Items: Appliances (Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers, Freezers and Refridgerators) **with Freon** content.
- Prohibited wastes:
 1. Batteries (or other non-ferrous metals), Fluorescent bulbs, Antifreeze, Paint products, Thinners or solvents, or items with mercury content.
 2. Yard wastes (Separate pickup)
